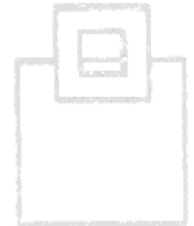
In part two we asked you to vote on which Use Cases you would like to see and I can happily say that the list was long and very even! However we did indeed have an outright winner :
